Objectives of the Fair:

- 2) To present to the public and visitors the initiatives of some communities for sustainable harvest and cultivation of edible mushrooms and other non-timber products.
- 3) To establish alliances between communities that collect mushrooms in order to improve management and strengthen commerce.

Program

Saturday August 11:

- Hike in the forests of Pueblos Mancomunados collecting and identifying mushrooms and learning about their habitat (interpretive trail) *Groups of 10 per guide*
- Contest: the basket with the most diverse species of mushrooms

- Main meal in the forest, learning activities.
- Accommodation in the community cabins (limited space)

Sunday August 12

- Conference about mushrooms and non-timber products
- Food Demonstration, mycology games, and drawing contest
- Exposition and sale of mushrooms and non-timber products
